

APPLYING FOR YMCA MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM AND CAMP ASSISTANCE

Step #1: Visit the Association Services Desk.

Go for a tour of the Brockville and Area YMCA at 345 Park Street to ensure the YMCA is the right fit for you. An Association Services Representative will arrange an appointment for you. These appointments are booked on a first come first serve basis.

Step #2: Complete the Financial Assistance Application Form and organize all income and expense documents.

Step #3. Arrive on time for your Financial Assistance Appointment. Because of the high demand for financial assistance appointments, it is important you arrive on time. **If you are late, your appointment may have to be rescheduled. If you must cancel or reschedule your appointment, please call the Brockville and Area YMCA at 613-342-7961 at least 24 hours in advance.**

Step #4: Your interview. Please bring your completed Financial Assistance Application Form and proof of household monthly income and expenses. We need this financial information to assess the fee you can afford to pay for your YMCA Membership/Programs/Camp. Everyone must pay a portion of the monthly fee. Your interview will be a personal assessment of your financial situation and will be confidential. The Brockville and Area YMCA is committed to protecting personal information by following responsible information handling practices. If you do not have the completed paperwork, **your meeting will be rescheduled.**

Step #5: Please be prepared to discuss which YMCA programs/camps interest you. To review the brochures, visit our website @www.brockvilley.com or Association Serices Desk for program/camp info.



MOST COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who Qualifies for Financial Assistance?

Residents of Brockville and Area whose financial circumstances make them unable, not unwilling, to pay the full fee for a Membership/Program/Camp.

What about the YMCA Building Fee?

The YMCA charges a one-time Building Fee for each Adult Membership (*as long as the membership does not lapse more than 90 days.*). This fee may be adjusted for those YMCA members who receive financial assistance.

Building fee does not apply to Programs/Camp.

How much financial assistance will be provided?

Everyone must pay a portion of the monthly fee. Some are able to pay more while others pay less. We assess everyone individually and ask you to bring your financial records to your interview.

If I receive YMCA financial assistance, what is expected of me?

Confidentiality. All information provided by you will be kept confidential. We request the same confidentiality from you.

Commitment. A YMCA Membership/Campership requires a commitment to making your payments on time. Financial Assistance may be denied and/or discontinued based on lack of commitment to the YMCA or agreed-upon financial commitments.

Member Etiquette. To enhance the YMCA experience, the Brockville and Area YMCA has established rules with respect to safety and acceptable behaviour. All YMCA members, guests, staff, and volunteers pledge to treat one another with respect and dignity.

Responsibility. If your financial situation changes and you no longer require assistance, please speak to a Association Services Representative. This enables the YMCA to help other individuals and families who are unable to pay the full fee.

How can I help out at the YMCA?
